

ACTIVE PLACES DATA PLATFORM COOKIES POLICY

Sport England is the brand name for The English Sports Council of First Floor, 21 Bloomsbury Street, London WC1B 3HF, a non-departmental public body under the Department for Culture, Media and Sport.

Unless otherwise noted, the terms "**Sport England**", "**we**", "**us**" or "**our**" on this page refer to The English Sports Council.

By "**you**" or "**your**", we mean you when you access and use the Active Places Data Platform website .

The Active Places Data Platform website may use cookies. A cookie is a small data file which asks permission to be placed on your computer's hard drive or other mobile or handheld device as you browse the Active Places Data Platform website (and may include technical information about your computer and/or device that may identify you, including your IP address, operating system, browser type, time-zone and browser plug-in details). The cookie may 'remember' that your computer or device accessed the Active Places Data Platform website . Once you agree to the cookie, the file is added to your computer's hard drive or other mobile or handheld device and the cookie helps us analyse web traffic and helps you when you visit the Active Places Data Platform website .

Cookies may be used to enable us to respond to you as an individual and to tailor our operations to your needs by gathering and remembering information about your preferences. Cookies can assist the effective operation of the Active Places Data Platform website (such as traffic log cookies to identify which pages are being used by you and which may help us analyse data for statistical purposes).

Through the use of analytics cookies, we process the following information:

- number of visitors to the website
- pages visited while at the website and time spent per page
- page interaction information, such as scrolling, clicks and browsing methods
- websites visitors have come from and where they go afterwards
- page response times and download errors
- other technical information relating to end user device, such as IP address or browser plug-in

In the course of this processing, we use Google Analytics from Google, Inc. (based outside the EU) on the Active Places Data Platform website for anonymous reporting of Website usage.
