Conformance status

The [Web Content Accessibility Guidelines \(WCAG\)](#) defines requirements for designers and developers to make web content more accessible to people with disabilities. It defines three levels of conformance: Level A, Level AA, and Level AAA.

The Active Places Data Platform is partially conformant with WCAG 2.1 level AAA.

Partially conformant means that some parts of the content do not fully conform to the accessibility standard.

Non-Conformities

The Active Places Data Platform includes some third-party components such as ESRI geospatial controls that are outside our control.

Note: Some hidden controls also report accessibility issues. These controls are not visible to, or used by, users when completing tasks within the Active Places Data Platform.
